<p><i>Most frequent convicted crime resulting in probation entry was non-trafficking drug offenses (26%), followed by driving while impaired (14%), larceny (13%), and assault (12%). Most parole entries were also non-trafficking drug offenses (13%), followed by assault (10%), and robbery (9%). The most frequent crime category for post-release supervision entries was non-trafficking drugs offenses (17%), followed by larceny (10%) and breaking and entering (9%).</i></p>
