#### **Reminders:**

Ethics: Sandy Dixon reminded the members of the General Statue, Chapter 138A-35, and other provisions of the State Government Ethics Act/Recusal.

#### **Review and Approval of Minutes:**

Sandy Dixon called attention to the meeting minutes for August 10, 2021. Ms. Rebecca Spragins moved to approve minutes; Ms. Susan Osborne seconded. The minutes were approved by the CVS Committee.

#### **CVS Planning Team Updates**

Sandy Dixon, GCC Lead Crime Victim Services Planner, reminded the Committee that CVS Funding FFY 2022 VAWA continues to be stable and VOCA has continued to decline with a high of \$103M in 2018 and only \$32M in FFY2021.

Sandy Dixon reviewed the two new priorities for application cycle November 1, 2021 – January 31, 2022.

The VOCA Fix passed Congress this summer. Changes it brought about are:

- 1. Deferred prosecution cases fines and penalties will be deposited into the Crime Victims Funds
- 2. GCC is now allowed to request a one-year extension on FFY awards.
- 3. Match waivers must be provided for the duration of a national emergency plus one year.
- 4. FFY2021 state VOCA Victim Assistance allocations we reduced due to new calculations for VOCA Victim Compensation allocations which resulted in \$1.6M less than GCC was originally awarded. However, 2019 reversions will cover GCC's intent for 2021 subawards.

#### **Presentation: The HAVI (The Health Alliance for Violence Intervention)**

An introduction to hospital-based violence intervention and prevention was provided by HAVI's Mark Ohrtman, Director of Planning and Design, and Sherah Liverpool-Archer, Senior Manager of Training and Technical Assistance. HAVI helps to provide technical assistance for hospitals and community organizations to establish hospital-based intervention and prevention programs. While prevention is still unallowable with VOCA VA funds, intervention efforts are allowed for those presenting at the hospital who have experience victimization.

- One year extensions now allowed
- Match Waivers for the duration of a national emergency plus one year
- FFY2021 state VOCA Victim Assistance allocations were reduced due to new calculations for VOCA Victim Compensation allocations
  - \$1.6M reduction
  - 2019 reversions will cover our GCC's intent on subawards
