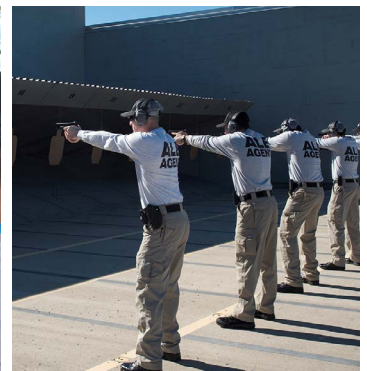
SALARY AND BENEFITS
