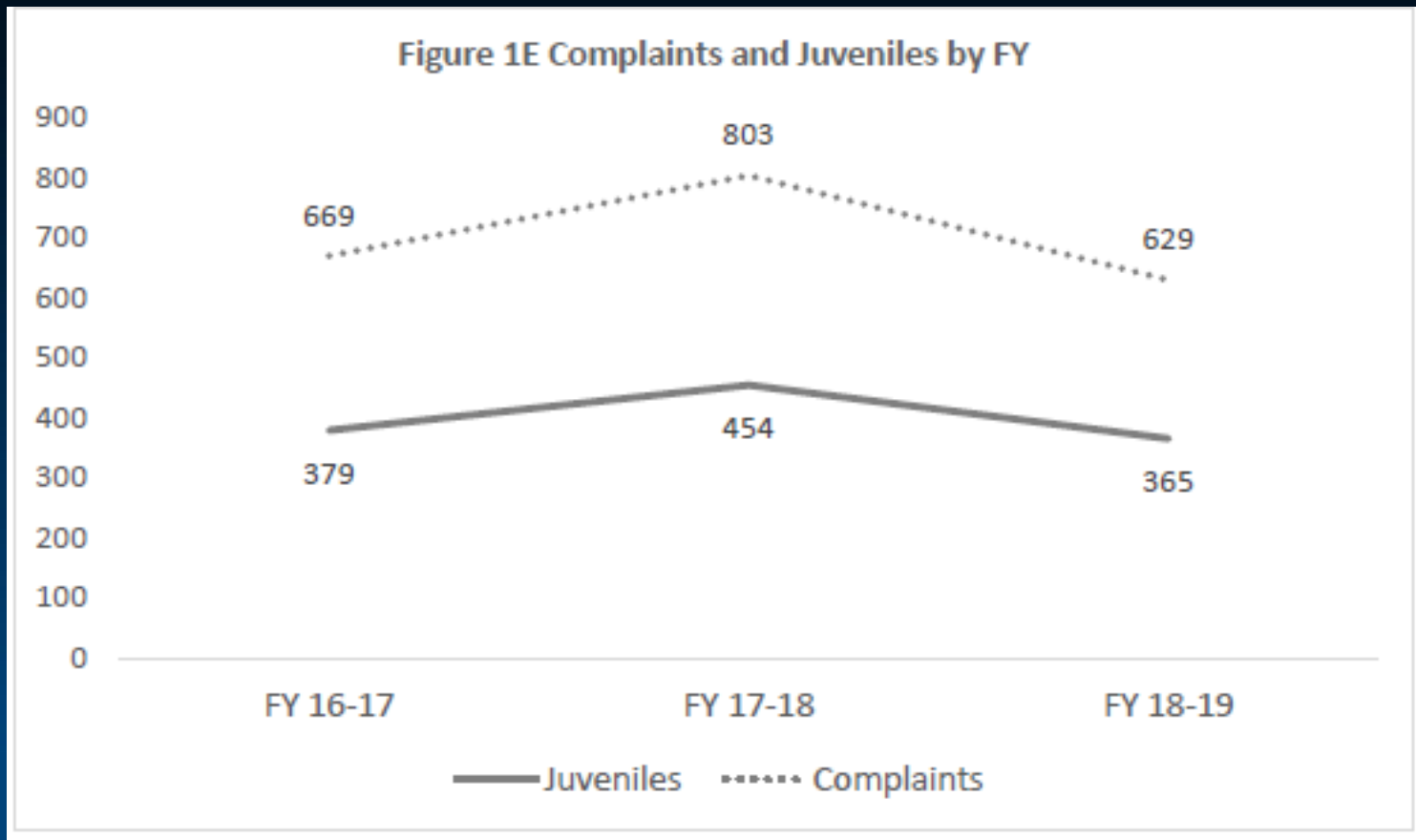


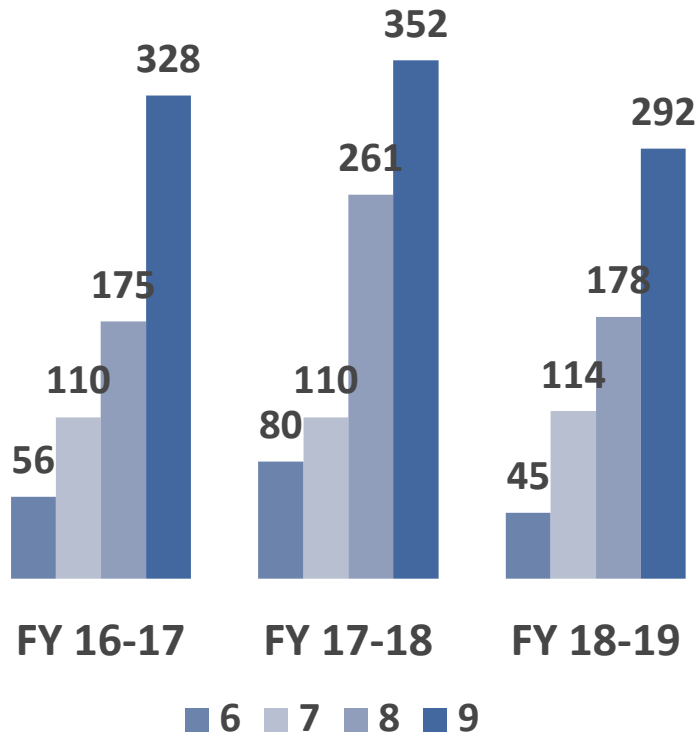
# Complaint Data: Juveniles Under Age 10

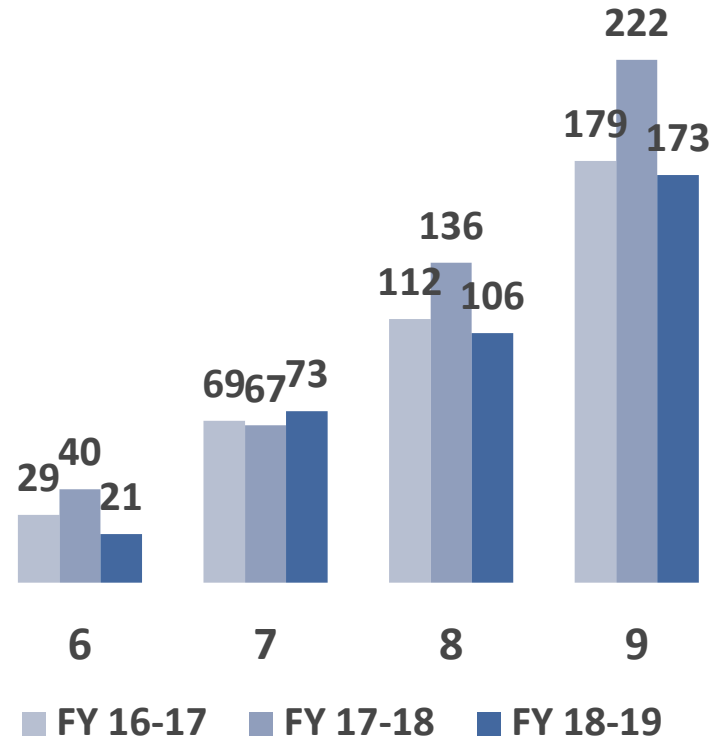


# Complaints Received & Distinct Juveniles By Age at Offense

Complaints by Age at Offense by Year

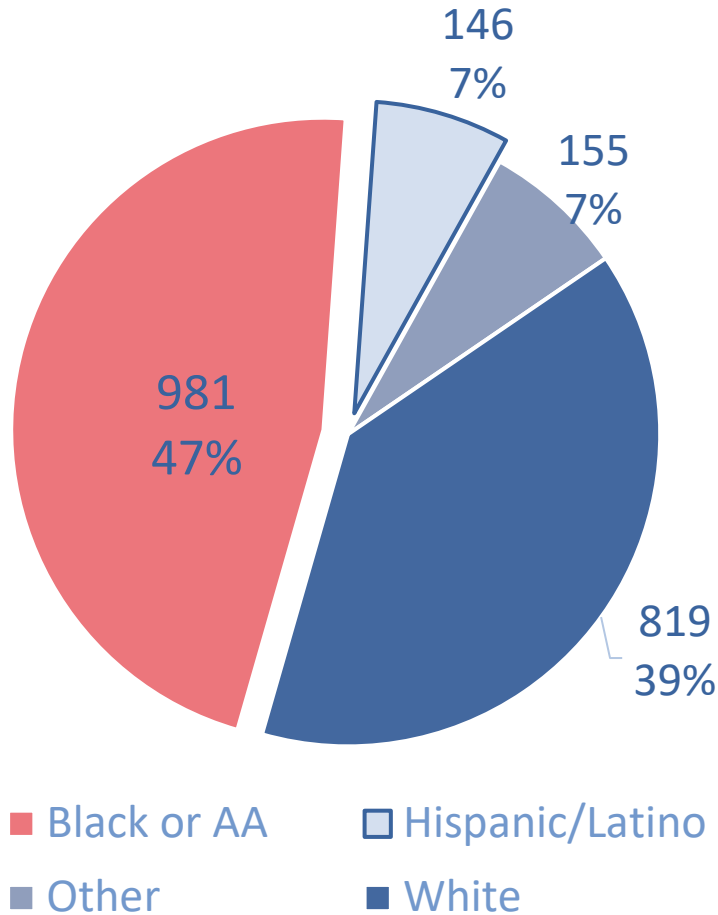


Distinct Juveniles by FY and Age at Offense

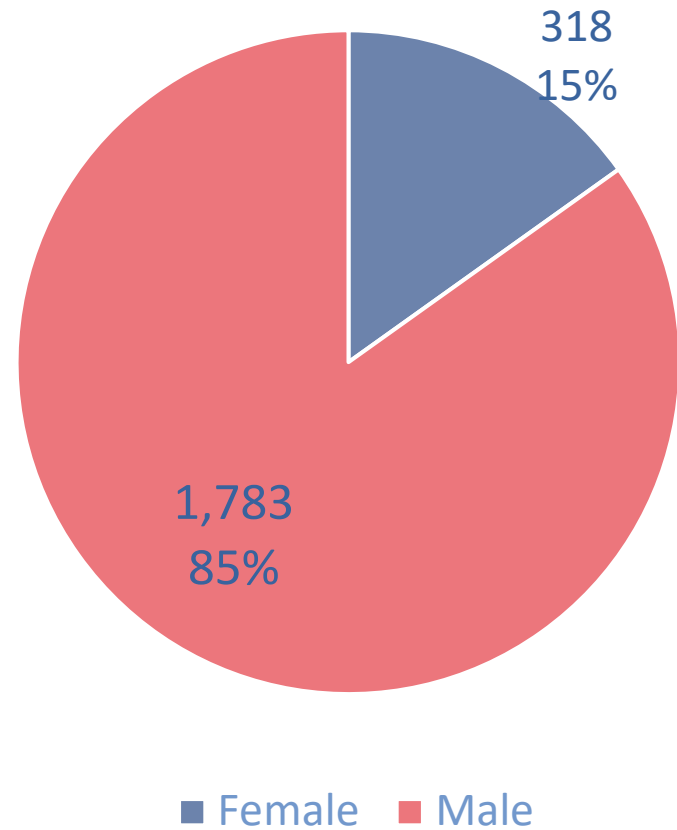


# Complaints Received by Race & Sex for <10 year olds

## Complaints by Sex

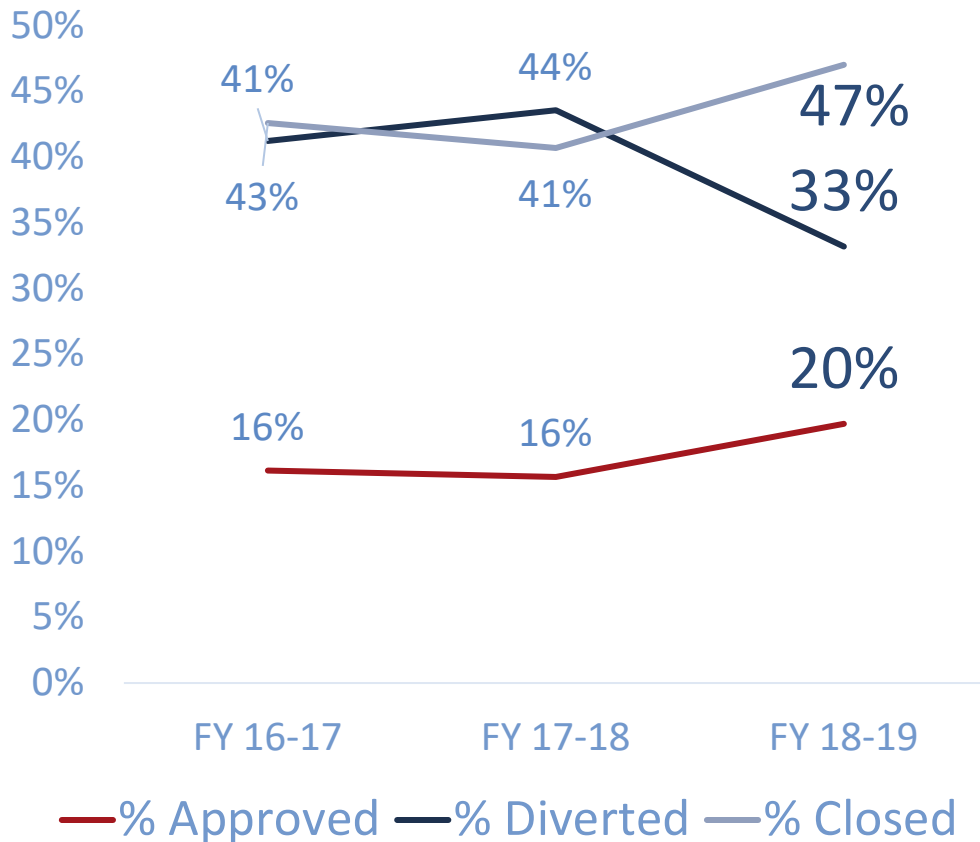


# School-Based Offenses (SBO's) by Age, 6-9 year olds

- ▶ 72% of complaints received during FY 16-17 through FY 18-19 were SBO's.
  - For youth age 6, SBO's were **92%** of all offenses.
  - For youth age 7, SBO's were **81%** of all offenses.
  - For youth age 8, SBO's were **74%** of all offenses.
  - For youth age 9, SBO's were **64%** of all offenses.

# Intake Decisions for 6-9 year olds

Complaints by Decision - Percentage



- ▶ In every year reviewed, at least 80% of complaints were either closed or diverted at intake.
- ▶ 42 youth were placed on probation supervision across all included fiscal years, and 12 were placed on protective supervision.
- ▶ There were no detention admissions.

# Serious Offenses

- ▶ **Between FY 16-17 and FY 18-19, 29 distinct juveniles presented with **58 A-G complaints**.**
  - 3 complaints were closed at intake and 2 were diverted at intake.
    - Neither diversion resulted in a post-diversion approval.
  - The remaining 53 complaints were approved for court.
  - Of these 53, 45 were dismissed and **8 were adjudicated**.
    - All 8 adjudications, received for 6 distinct juveniles, were sex offenses.
