This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding between the North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission (NC HTC) and [redacted] demonstrating our commitment to collaborate on behalf of victims of human trafficking in North Carolina.

**BACKGROUND**

[redacted] is submitting a grant proposal to the North Carolina Governor’s Crime Commission under the **Crime Victims’ Services Committee 2022 Request for Applications Funding Priorities, Section E (Underserved Crime Victims)** to provide core crisis intervention services to victims of human trafficking in North Carolina (the Grant Proposal).

The NC HTC is the legislatively mandated leader of anti-human trafficking efforts in North Carolina per S.L. 2013-368. The Commission is housed in and staffed by the N.C. Judicial Branch.

**STATEMENT OF COLLABORATION**

The NC HTC and [redacted] commit to collaborate on behalf of victims of human trafficking in North Carolina by, among other things, sharing updates about implementation of the Grant Proposal; sharing information learned in implementation of the Grant Proposal about human trafficking in North Carolina, including but not limited to incidence, demographics, and typology; and collaborating in training, outreach, and awareness efforts.
