**RE:** Transfer of DPS Administrative Positions to the Department of Adult Correction

**DATE:** October 19, 2022

*Pursuant to Session Law 2021-180, Section 19C.9.(www), the Department of Public Safety (DPS) shall determine the number of positions currently assigned to the Administrative Division of DPS that should be transferred to the Department of Adult Correction created in this section. DPS shall submit an interim report on this matter to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on or before March 15, 2022, and a final report no later than October 1, 2022.*

The following positions were transferred on October 7, 2022.

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As a result of the transfer of administrative positions, the Department of Public Safety will retain 5,749 full-time equivalent positions overall while the Department of Adult Correction will have a total of 20,093 full-time equivalent positions. Currently, DPS has a 1:44 ratio of administrative positions per full-time equivalent positions. Going forward, DPS will have a 1:29 ratio and DAC will have a 1:51 ratio.
