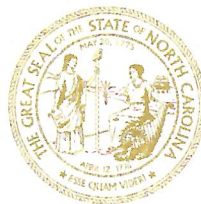
SL 2023-134, Section 19C.1. INTERSTATE COMPACT FEES TO SUPPORT TRAINING PROGRAMS AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASES SECTIONS

SECTION 19C.1.(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 148-65.7, fees collected for the Interstate Compact Fund during the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium may be used by the Department of Adult Correction during the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium to provide training programs and equipment purchases for the Division of Community Supervision and Reentry, but only to the extent sufficient funds remain available in the Fund to support the mission of the Interstate Compact Program.

SECTION 19C.1.(b) No later than October 1 of each fiscal year, the Department of Adult Correction shall report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on the amount of funds used pursuant to this section and for what purposes the funds were used.

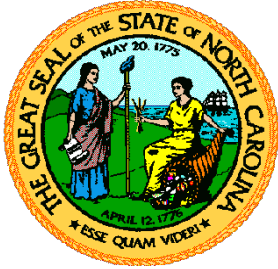

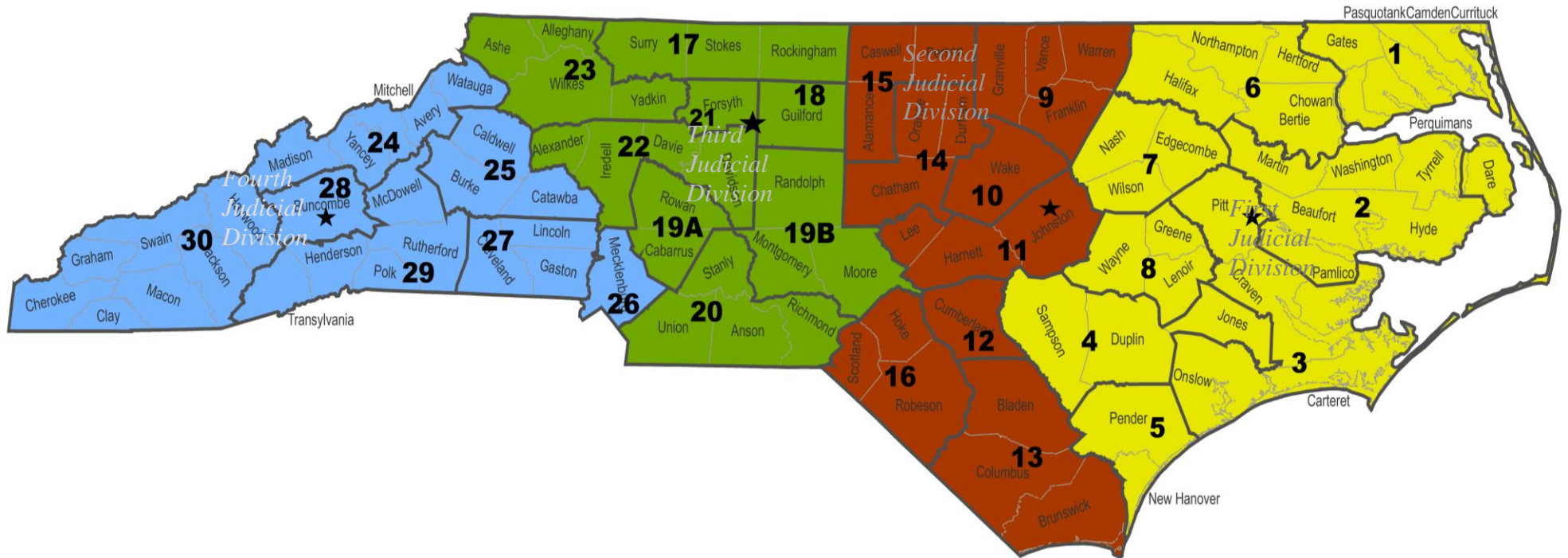

Overview of Interstate Compact

It is the purpose of this compact and the Interstate Commission, through means of joint and cooperative action among the compacting states: (1) To provide the framework for the promotion of public safety and to protect the rights of victims through the control and regulation of the interstate movement of offenders in the community; (2) To provide for the effective tracking, supervision, and rehabilitation of these offenders by the sending and receiving states; and (3) To equitably distribute the costs, benefits, and obligations of the compact among the compacting states.

Financial Overview for Fiscal Year 2023-2024

In the fiscal year 2023-2024, the Department of Adult Correction allocated \$93,356.79 from the Interstate Compact Fee Fund for various training programs and equipment purchases:

1. Leadership Development Training
 - Provider: Ron Ward
 - Date: January 30, 2024
 - Participants: 100 managers and supervisors
 - Location: Doubletree by Hilton, Raleigh Crabtree Valley
 - Cost: \$7,500
2. Trauma Informed Desistance Training
 - Provider: TIDES, LLC
 - Date: March 19-21, 2024
 - Participants: 35 security risk group (SRG) officers
 - Location: Davidson-Davie Community College, Thomasville, NC
 - Cost: \$42,828
3. Best Practices Approach to Supervising Transgender Individuals in a Community Setting
 - Provider: The Moss Group
 - Dates: June 4 and June 6, 2024
 - Participants: 100 officers (50 at each session)
 - Locations: Wake Technical Community College, Raleigh, NC, and Western Piedmont Community College, Morganton, NC
 - Cost: \$29,903.79
4. Oral Drug Screening Supplies
 - Provider: Redwood Labs
 - Cost: \$13,125

Additionally, \$199,845 was transferred from this fund to the main operating fund for the Interstate Compact, as is customary each year.

Fund Balance and Future Plans

As of June 30, 2024, the balance of the Interstate Compact Fee Fund was \$502,363. Plans for 2025 include utilizing funds for outfitting a Mobile Command Trailer for the DCS Emergency Response Team, enhancing operational readiness and response capabilities.
